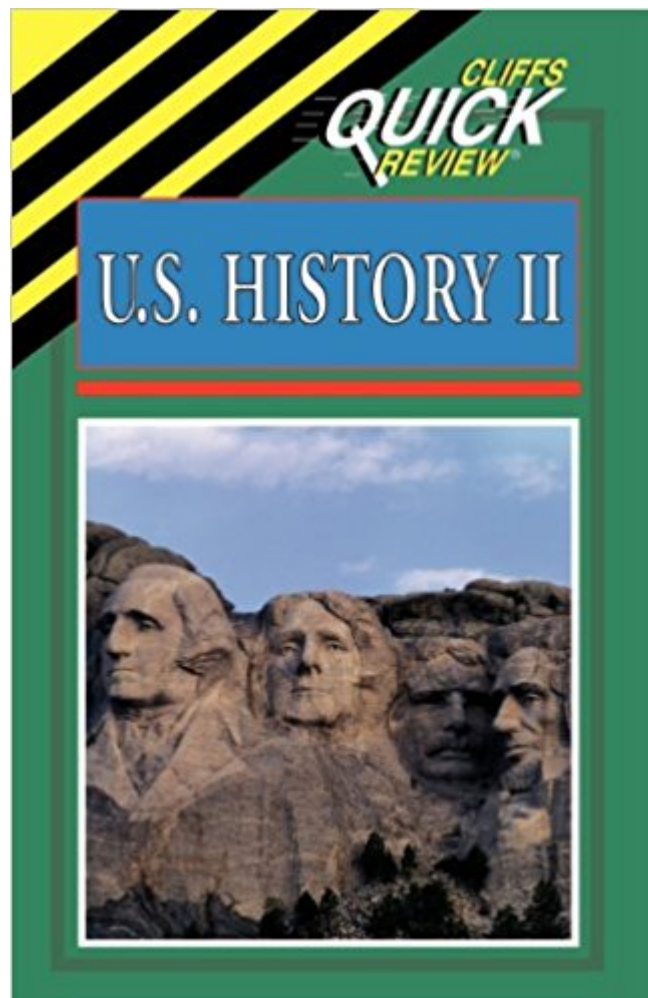




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Abraham Hoffman received his PhD in History from UCLA and has done research in California and Western history.
