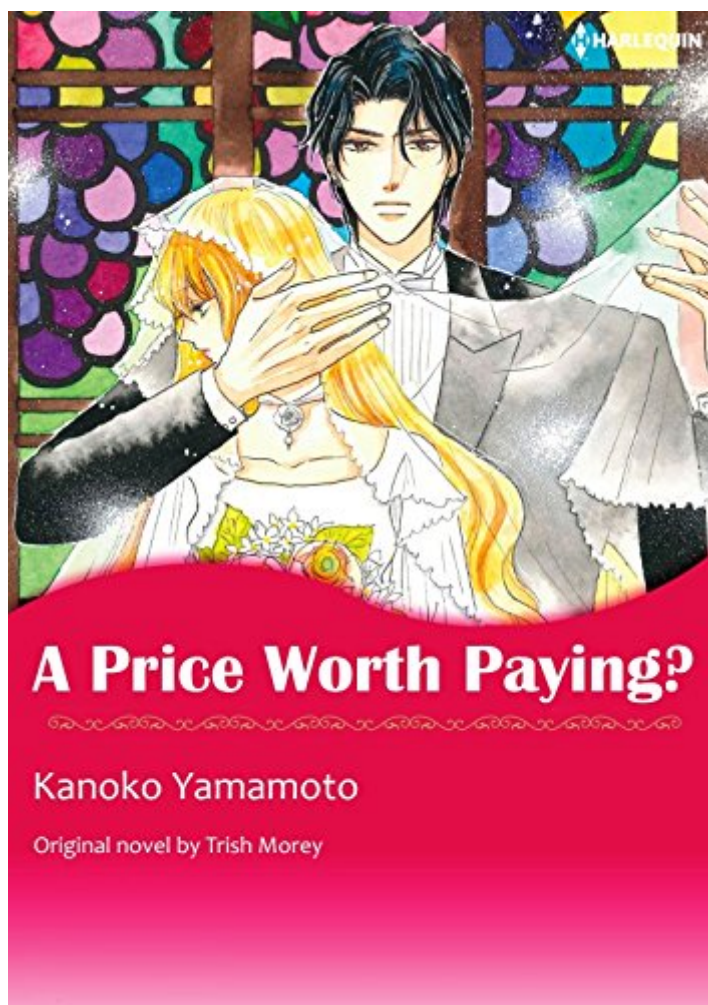

After reading *A Price Worth Paying?*, I tell you right now, I want to go back to Spain and soak up the sun on the sunny shores once again. So, here are my thoughts on *A Price Worth Paying?*: I absolutely adore friends-to-lovers romance, but I am always bang-up for a good enemies to lovers story as well. And there is a thoroughly delicious one that plays out in *A Price Worth Paying?*. There is an incendiary chemistry that burns between Simone and Alesander. Two starkly different people, with very different ideas on what their marriage of convenience will mean for them. I loved that despite their initial misgivings about each other, due to their own preconceptions, they grew to see something in the other that filled a previously unknown part of them. The intimate scenes between Simone and Alesander are super-sexy and incredibly sensual. When you get to their wedding night scene, you will definitely understand to what I am alluding. There be hotness in them there pages! Simone's desire to make her grandfather's last days happy ones touched my heart. While she may not have realised everything about the back story, I love that she was so caring towards someone she basically knew very little about. I loved the take-charge, alpha-man that is Alesander. I loved that I was allowed, as a reader to imagine how he sounded, rather than having it spelled out. Those who know me know I have a major weakness for the Spanish accent, so I was in heaven imagining this. I tell you, there isn't much more that's hotter than watching an alpha-man brought to his knees by love. The sultry Spanish setting and the hot, sensual romance all add up to a most satisfying read. *A price worth paying?* Most definitely!

In *A Price Worth Paying?* by Trish Morey Simone's and Alesander's families were bitter rivals, going back generations. Their Spanish vineyards abutted each other's, and Alesander's family cursed Simone's and vowed they would someday be driven from the land that they wished to make their

own. When Simone hears that her grandfather is deathly ill, she returns to Spain to be with him in his final months. She also learns that in his despair over losing his only daughter and her husband he gambled away most of the family's land. He sinks deeper and deeper realizing that he will never regain what he has lost. That's when Simone concocts a plan. Knowing only bits and pieces of the history behind the feud, she goes to Alesander Esquivel and makes him an offer he would be a fool to refuse. Marry her, making Felipe believe the families have reunited, the land becoming one - the curse broken. In return, once he's finally passed away and she inherits his estate, she will sign the land over to him and return to Australia. She's adamant about one thing - it will be a marriage in name only. He balks, but ultimately agrees to the deal. When he starts to see the woman beneath the pain and baggy clothing, he decides that's not enough for him anymore. He wants everything. After falling for him, she learns the truth of the curse and things go a bit awry. How can she love him when she hates him so damn much? Alesander is definitely an alpha hero, several times becoming forceful with Simone - but not uncomfortably so. The sex scenes are very hot for a Presents title - enough that I was almost fanning myself after reading about their wedding night. I've read several of Ms. Morey's books, and I've liked all of them.
