


The book was found

I love Cynthia Rylant's writing and I was really glad I ordered this book. Lot's of amazing stories about the positive impact animals have in the lives of humans. I teach 4th and 5th grade gifted students and we did some great close reading with several of these stories.

Somehow I failed to realize that this is a little chapter book with the kind of cheap binding that is difficult to open all the way. The pages are printed on that dark recycled paper. The stories are nice, and my second graders like them, but I learned that I don't love Cynthia Rylant's voice as much when not paired with beautiful illustrations like I'm used to.

I have purchased this book three times for my classes, because it seems to never stay on the shelf for long. Each one of these stories shows how an animal can change a person's life. My favorite stories, in particular, are "Slower Than the Rest" and "Stray". Cynthia Rylant is able to weave a wonderful story about something as simple as encountering an animal, and having that animal change us for the better. They make a great read aloud, as well as silent reading.

I wasn't aware it was a book aimed mostly at upper elementary kids, but think the stories are good and that kids would enjoy them. I enjoyed them, but was well aware it wasn't written for an adult. Since I am an animal lover, I was pleasantly amused.
