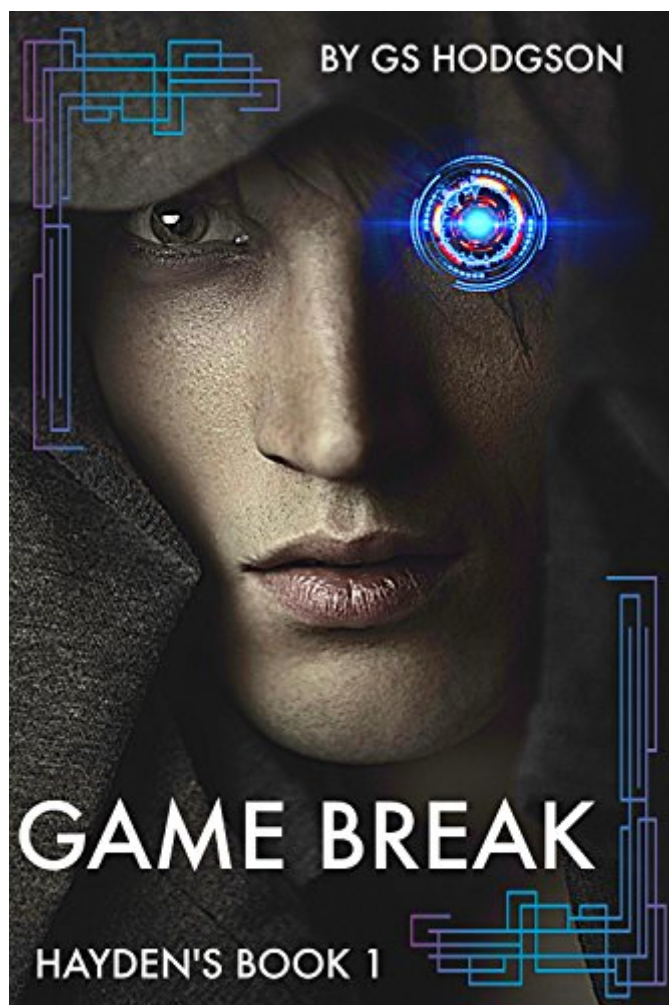

As the heading stated, this is a very good idea, and the storyline is quite interesting. The good: It has a few twists and turns that you don't see coming, some good characterisation, interesting monsters

and the faceless enemy in the background. The bad: way, way to many spelling or auto correction of words - words which could change the entire sentence meaning, possible overuse of Australian slang without providing some background. With regards to the slang, I am a fellow Australian, and am overjoyed at seeing another getting ahead in this genre, but, if I told a tourist to "have a butchers" or a "captain cook", let go and have a sticky beak at something, none of them would understand I meant for them to have a look at something without some background, especially to how Strine came about. The Australian language, lingo, slang, call it what you will, is littered with so many incomprehensible sayings for foreigners, tourists and new immigrants it might as well be a second or third English language. Anyway, the book has some good points, a few bad points, and a couple of nice digs at a few memes, the only thing letting it down is spelling and editing. Right-o, I'm off to the pub, I've got a couple of rock lobsters in my sky rocket and I'm having a dogs eye with dead horse for lunch with a couple of sherbets, (\$40 in my pocket having a meat pie with sauce and a couple of beers).

This is a story about online MMO gaming in a future time when virtual reality blurs the line between real and not real. As a gamer myself, I quite enjoyed the slow evolution of the story and the world building. I was also intrigued by the hints of a darker story slowly unfolding in the background. But there were two issues that stopped me from giving the story a higher score. One was the editing, and the other was a technical issue involving the Kindle. This story could really do with a professional edit. 'Nuff said. The technical issue has to do with the way the Kindle processes the 'graphic' parts of the novel. The display of in-game stats and messages literally threw the page turns out of whack, forcing me to manually centre each new page so I could read it. I also have to say that I found the frequent stats annoying after a while. In a game I'm playing, yes, they're important and I'm happy to spend a lot of time looking at the best options. In a story of someone else's game? Not so. Criticisms aside, however, both the story and the author have great potential. That's why I decided to write this review, even though it was critical.

Love the story and the character development is good but some paragraphs are repeated and there are some grammar mistakes that interrupt the flow of the story.

This story is about a MC who is living in a virtual game world but doesn't how he got there or anything else about himself. The world is in a RPG gaming setting. Level and questing abounds. Nice story, plot moves along. Will be getting the sequel.

Lots of editing problems. The often had a poor flow to it, one paragraph to the next were not smooth. Many times the dialog felt as if the author suddenly remembered he left something out and tried to shoehorn it in. From the writing style, I would guess the author is late teens. Decent imagination though, with some writing classes and a number of years of practice, we might see some good books. But as for now, unless you are someone who goes through 5+ books a week, don't bother.
