

Trying to research more about the track I only ever ended up in online forums for off-road motor biking. I wasn't really surprised that I couldn't find a single report about someone doing it by bicycle. This book is about the days I crossed through the Moroccan Sahara on my bicycle on a small and remote desert path. But it is also about my first days in the country, the route towards Zagora and how I felt cycling through Morocco. It includes maps,pictures, a price list, route suggestions and travel tips for exploring the country in a self-sufficient and responsible way.
