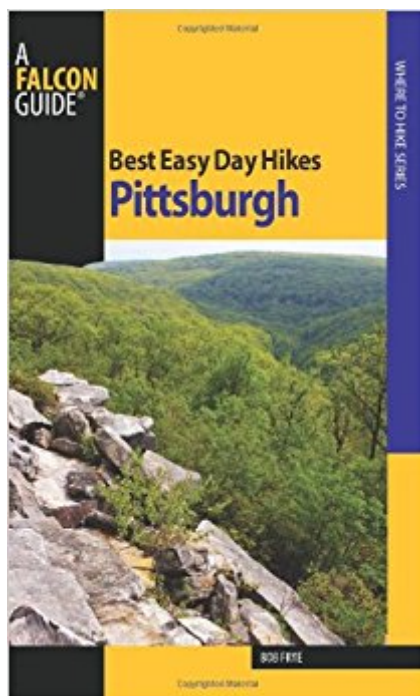

not very detailed. The dimensions of the book are only about six inches by three inches. I have only myself to blame for not checking the details more closely. Caveat emptor!
