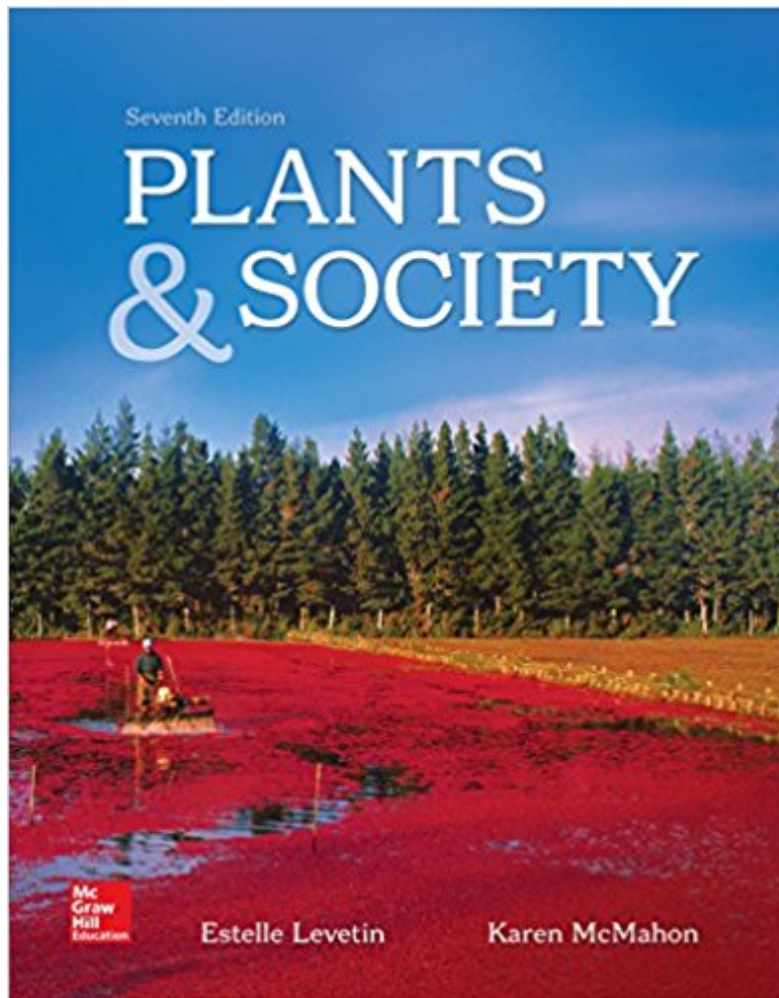




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# Plants And Society (Botany, Zoology, Ecology And Evolution)
