The rest of the story concerns a murder, and perhaps a few more in the past, including the man who has died and one of his daughters. The book kept me reading although was a bit disjointed at times and hard to follow. I am not sure I ever really could imagine the characters too much. But, an okay read with a rather complicated ending.

Ugh, what a horrible editing job. So many spelling and grammatical errors. I was finally pushed to the point of reviewing after the improper usage of your vs you're, but there are points where they misspell a character's name or write settle instead of subtle. Was this book written by voice to text and then not reread?! On top of that, it's a serious struggle to stay interested and it seems very redundant at many points. I have read worse, so I'm giving 2 stars, but I don't think I can make myself finish this book. Download a different book, even if this one is free.

Talk about walking into a hornet nest! Eric is taking some time to get his life back on track, after being accused of murder, only to be invited, unknowingly, into a rich family's lies, deceit and

murder. Good mix in the cast of characters. Interesting little twists and turns to a satisfying end. This book, like most others I've been reading lately, has been very poorly edited. Spell checker doesn't catch the missing or misplaced words, nor the grammar mistakes. Someone really needs to actually read the manuscripts before they're published.

I recommend reading this book. I read it in a couple of days and as pleased that the ending was a total surprise!
