

Although sometimes a bit simplistic in its tone, I nonetheless truly enjoyed learning more about the true history of this great lady. Instead of capitalizing on the sensational things that have over the years been either revealed about her or simply attached to her in order to discredit her memory, this book shows us her true history, and why she deserved to be labeled "The Great" in her own lifetime.

I enjoyed learning about this very powerful and astute woman. Also learned so much about the history, society, and culture of Russia. I see now why communism was attractive there. There was no "middle class." If you were a serf, life was lived under horrid conditions and they later revolted. I like this lady's mind...she was tough!

Simmons' transports you to the savage Russian lands as Sophia (Catherine) and her silly, narcissistic mother travel in anticipation of Princess Sophia marrying Empress Elizabeth's heir Peter, who has no interest in being ruler of Russia. Catherine overcomes many obstacles on her way to becoming Catherine The Great.
