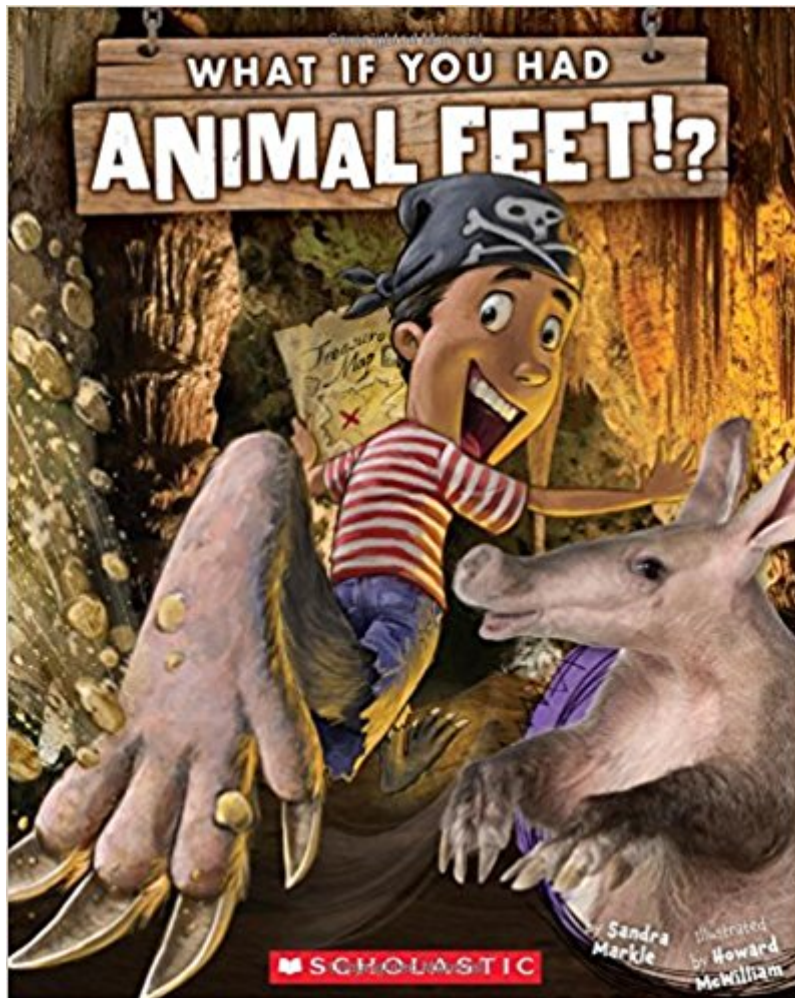

The illustrations are charming and even inspired several of my students to create their OWN illustrations of themselves with animal body parts. The author did a great job of teaching an important science concept in a funny, engaging way. I love these books so much that I just pre-ordered the next book in the series, which is coming out right as school is starting. These books would make a great addition to ANY collection, whether it's at home or at school or whether it's for learning or just for fun. You'll enjoy them for sure!

I read this last week to my grandson's 2nd grade class, and they loved it!!!! I did something that made it more fun, I think. The format of this book is the left side has the "non-fiction" facts about a particular animal, and the right page, has a picture of a child with that animal's teeth. To keep the "surprise," I covered the right side of the book so the class couldn't see the picture of child until they heard the fact page, and then I took the cover off. It worked exactly as I hoped! They loved the surprise rather than looking at that picture while I read the facts on the left. A real hit...
