For less than 15k words, Meghan O'Brien did a wonderful job of developing the backstory (predominately the high school years) of both of the characters, Juliet and Drew. The story plays off this background which mainly dealt with bullying behavior during high school. The progress of what happens over the two hours that they spend together goes a long way in healing old wounds and is incredibly sexy. Don't miss this book by Meghan. One suggestion for the author is better advertising of her work. I didn't even know this book existed until I was looking for "Her Best Friend's Sister", which will be released next week, on my Kindle app.

Although The Client is told in the third person, it's all from Juliet's perspective during her two-hour session with her new client. For a short story, she's amazingly well fleshed out, which may be at least in part because of the premise (which I'm trying desperately not to spoil, because, trust me, you really don't want it to be spoiled). For that matter, so is her client. For a story that's less than 15,000 words, a lot of depth goes into these two characters and their time together, making for a very satisfying story.

I've read several of O'Brien's books. I have found that they are both extremely hot but often extremely emotional as well. Granted this was a short story, but like her other works, it did carry an emotional element. It wasn't just erotica for the sake of being dirty.

To begin with, this is a great plot which the author fleshed out with 2 very realistic characters that each have their own, distinct voices. The writing is smooth and well crafted. Plus, holy moly this was a sauna...super steamy.

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
